【Science (Pink Zone)】

In the General Course, all students study "Basic Physics" while in the Foreign Language Course students study "Basic Biology".

Throughout the 1st and 2nd years, students in the General Course study 3 basic subjects ("Basic Chemistry", "Basic Biology" and "Basic Physics") while students in the Foreign Language Course study only "Basic Biology".

【English (Light Blue Zone)】

Students in the General Course study English for 6 hours in total per week while students in the Foreign Language Course study for 8 hours, having "English Conversation" class in addition to common "Communication English 1" and "English Expression 1".
